Music Report, Church Council meeting

April 2012

Some of the latest highlights include:

- The choir has participated in 5 outreach programs so far including Christmas. Recently we sang at the Stuarts Draft Christian Home, and presented an Easter program for Summit Square. In May we will do an outreach at Birch Gardens. I am looking into summer opportunities for the choir.
- Choir attendance continues to be strong for the 11:00 service. I am especially excited about including our young people in the choir. Anyone high school age on up is welcome.
- Kidz Praise presented special music on Palm Sunday and is currently working on a piece for Mother's Day.
- The pre-school children will present special music either the last Sunday in April or first Sunday in May for the 11:00 church service.
- Bell choir successfully recruited 2 permanent players since our "Try a Bell" campaign last October. We presented special music for Palm Sunday and plan to do 1 or 2 more pieces before taking a summer break. We still need a couple more ringers. We especially want to encourage the high school youth to be part of the bell choir.
- Looking to the summer, I am planning for a lot of summer music, including solos, trios, guest groups such as the flute choir, or youth orchestra. We are also looking into the possibility of a brass group. There will be more info on summer as plans develop.
- Spring/summer is also the time I like to evaluate our music program with members of the music committee and make goals for the fall. I would appreciate feedback from church members as we evaluate the best use of our resources. Please share your thoughts with Eloise.
- Many thanks again to all of the volunteers that make our music program a reality.
